- Affidavit of Candidacy

- Must be filled out by candidate and filed with the County Auditor at the Courthouse in Anamosa by 5PM on June 14, 2024.
- o The County Auditor is a notary and can notarize this form for you.

- Nomination Petition

- o This petition must be filed with the County Auditor at the same time as you file your affidavit of candidacy.
- o The minimum number of signatures required is 10. Collecting more signatures that what you need is advised.
- o Signers must be eligible electors of the city in which you reside.

- Offices on Ballot

- o There will be 4 City Council Seats, To Fill a Vacancy on the ballot.
- \circ You must choose which term limits you are running for. There is 1 seat with a term expiring on 1/2/26 and 3 seats with terms expiring on 1/2/28.

- Candidate Guide

- o Candidate Information from the Secretary of State.
- IA Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board letter
