- **2:00 p.m.** Auditor, Recorder, and Treasurer meet to determine whether to proceed with an appointment at a later date, or to call a special election, to fill the vacancy in the office of Jones County Supervisor District 4.
  - If the committee determines to proceed with an appointment, a notice will be published in the legal notices section of the two official Jones County newspapers not less than four days nor more than twenty days prior to the meeting at which the appointment is made, as required by law. Said publication will include the provisions by which the public may file a petition calling for a special election after the appointment is made.
  - If the committee determines to proceed with a special election, the committee may order the election at its January 8, 2025 meeting. If this option is selected by the committee, the election is required to be held at the earliest practicable date, but giving at least 32 days notice of the election, and shall be held on a Tuesday. When determining an election date, the committee would take into consideration the need for the county Democratic and Republican political parties to reconvene their county conventions to select their respective candidate prior to the candidate filing deadline. Nonpartisan candidates would need to solicit 75 signatures on nomination petitions.
